We will be shaping the event around the elements of the above "guide to new and developed schools". There will be some world café type discussions, a choice of meetings around particular themes, several presentations of different kinds by individuals connected to the Education for Social Renewal Foundation. There will be opportunities for participants to present their thoughts and questions.

We will be looking at how all aspects of the life of a Steiner school can be inspired and enlivened by the threefold social impulse. This includes curriculum content, teaching methods, work of the College of Teachers and school governance. Importantly, it will include how the threefold social picture can become a matter of continual striving and inspiration within a school. To some extent it will include the relationship of a school to the broader social outlook – specifically, the economic, political-rights and cultural-spiritual spheres of society.

Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea will be provided on both days (more details in the next communication). There is no charge for the actual event – we consider your effort to prepare for and travel to the event sufficient. The Education for Social Renewal Foundation will cover its own travel expenses.
